

Works on the Lake Madine Leisure Bases - Information for Anglers

Pending further discussions with the local water authority (syndicat des eaux de la région messine) managing the works, here is a provisional protocol to access the fishing zones:

Access to Carp Fishing Swims 1 to 12:

The path below the dike is closed, currently scheduled until mid-June.

Access to the swims is now via the gate located in Heudicourt, next to the "Bar du Lac." Follow the lakeside path to reach your swim.

Access Badges: Your gate badges have been reprogrammed by our team.

Access to the Heudicourt gate is now open for this period.

To avoid disrupting other leisure activities on the path, you may only pass through this gate during the following windows: before 12:00 PM and after 5:30 PM.

Please note that access is strictly prohibited on the following dates due to onsite events:

Thursday, May 14th: Light on Run

Saturday, June 13th & Sunday, June 14th: Rétro Meus'Autos

Parking: Anglers must park along the lakeside path near the waste disposal center (déchetterie).

Vehicles must not block the ongoing works or obstruct other path users (pedestrians, service vehicles, etc.).

Extreme caution is required when driving on the path. In this "shared zone," the speed limit is 20 km/h. Pedestrians and cyclists have priority. You must drive with your hazard lights on for the duration of the trip.

Boat Launch Access (Marmont Dike / Petit Port):

The boat launch at the end of this dike is closed **until mid-May**.

Launching remains possible at the Heudicourt observatory and the Montsec boat launch.

As work progress depends on weather conditions, these dates may change. We will keep you updated on any further developments.
